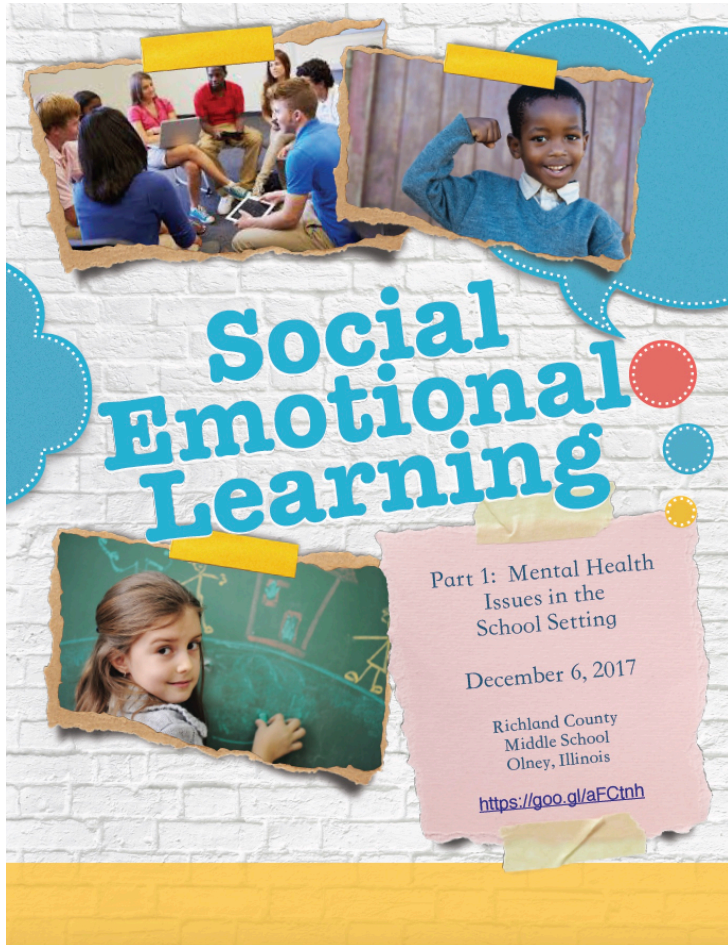

Participants explored how mental health issues affects student learning and behavior. The workshop provided an overview of mental illness behaviors and stigmas, including warning signs and next steps.

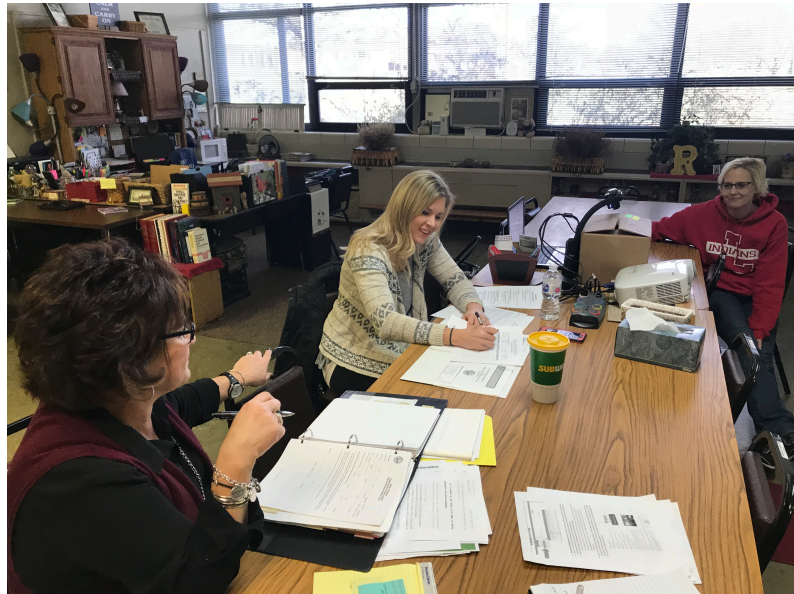


**School Nurses' Network - Fall**
